1 cutworm report - **New Norway**

1 staging caution

1 plot / demo site location request

- I have some growers in New Norway that have damage from cut worms. In one case the **canola was not emerging** and upon investigation was discovered that the cut worms were **active below the surface**. On the other case the field has about 30% loss and the grower is spraying Decis.

- Many growers have been waiting to spray their peas because of dry conditions and limited weed pressure. To maximize crop safety **WATCH the staging** after this rain and spray accordingly.... Short peas with advanced node stage appear to be common.
